The person we find to support you is called a **citizen advocate**.



Our citizen advocates are **volunteers**.



That means they support someone with lots of different things but do not get paid.



We match you with the right advocate to support you.



We support the person and their new advocate when they are matched.



Support can be with things like

- Phone calls
- Support for you to get together
- Events to keep you in contact.
