If you need help to read this, please ask a friend, family member, or support worker.


What we do

Our Values (How We Work)


These are the important ways we work and think:

We started 8 new friendships (advocacy matches).




We kept 51 long-term friendships going strong.

Liz has been a friend to Lucy since 2017.


Liz is a volunteer advocate. This is a friend who stands outside the paid support system.

Most of this was from the government.




We got some extra money from grants and bank interest.


